CREATES THE LEGAL REGIME OF SOCIAL PROTECTION IN THE EVENT OF UNEMPLOYMENT FOR INDEPENDENT EMPLOYEES SUPPLYING SERVICES MAINLY TO ONE CONTRACTING ENTITY.

In the event of involuntary termination of the contract with the independent employee supplying services mainly to a single entity, it is attributed to the same the termination of activity subsidy, or the termination of activity partial subsidy (in case the latter maintains a professional activity equivalent to 20% or less of the aggregate annual value of its work income), in this manner being extended to this group of employees the protection in the event of unemployment.

Thus, this regime extends the protection in case of unemployment to this group of employees, the guarantee duration being larger when compared with the social protection regime of the employees hired by a third party.

It is also excluded the possibility of accessing the retirement pension age flexibility access regime.
