## EMIGRATION LAW

### LAW N.º29/2017, OF MAY 30TH

**THE LAW NO. 29/2017 OF MAY 30TH REGULATES THE POSTING OF WORKERS IN THE FRAMEWORK OF THE PROVISION OF SERVICES, AS WELL AS THE RELATED ADMINISTRATIVE COOPERATION THROUGH THE INTERNAL MARKET INFORMATION SYSTEM.**

The Law no. 29/2017 of May 30th regulates the posting of workers in the framework of the provision of services, as well as the related administrative cooperation through the Internal Market Information System.

The Law no. 29/2017 of May 30th transposes the European Parliament and Council Directive 2014/67/EC, of May the 15th, 2014, related to the execution of the European Parliament and Council Directive 96/71/EC, of December 16th, 1996, regarding the posting of workers in the framework of the provision of services, and amending the Regulation (EU) no. 1024/2012 of the European Parliament and Council, of October 25th, 2012, related to the administrative cooperation through the Internal Market Information System.

This Law is applicable to situations of posting of workers in the Portuguese territory as well as to situations of posting of workers in another Member State, in the framework of the provision of services.

Among the innovations foreseen in this Law, the following deserve mention: the creation of measures of mutual assistance and administrative cooperation between Member States as well as the protection of the worker's rights in Portuguese territory.

For the purposes of this Law the national competent authority is The Authority for Working Conditions (AWC).

This Law will come into force on 01 June 2017.
